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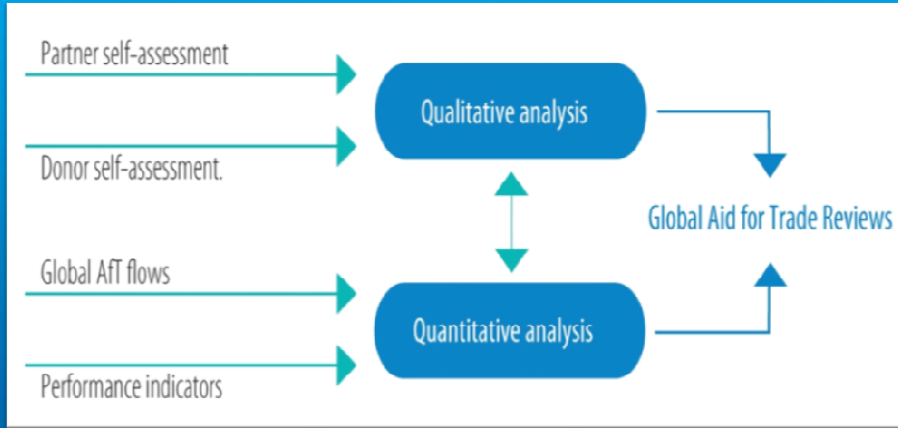

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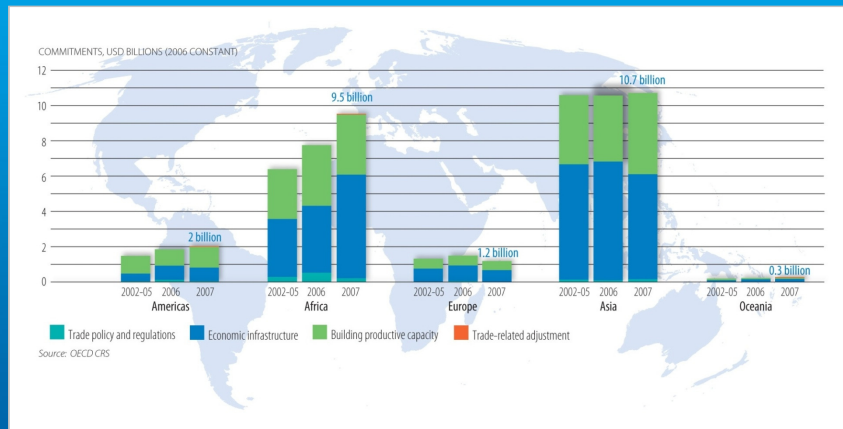

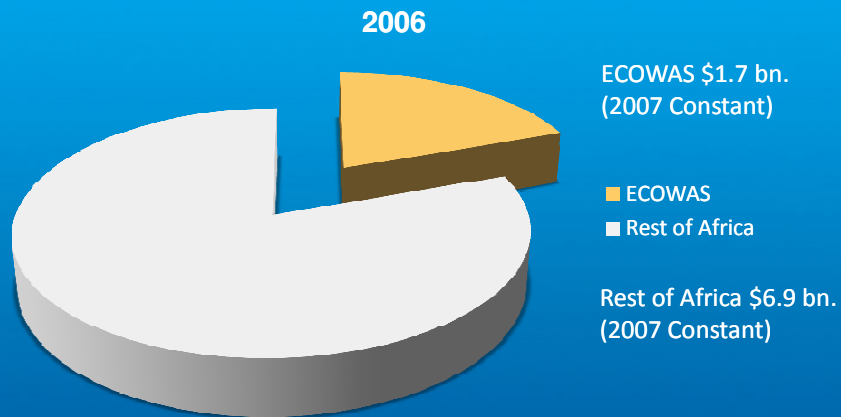


Aid for Trade is working: More Awareness, More Resources

ECOWAS is increasing its share...

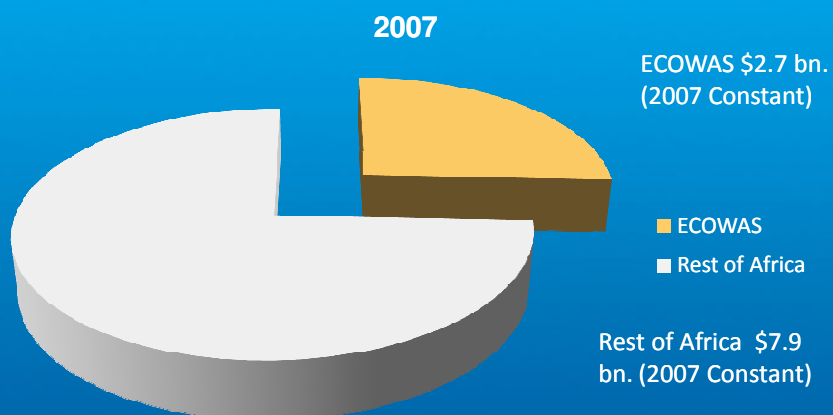


ECOWAS \$1.7 bn.

...of growing AfT flows to Africa...

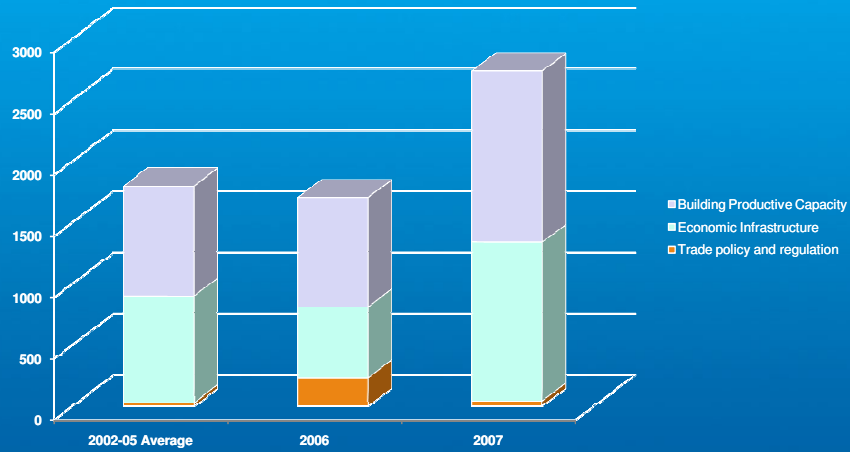


ECOWAS \$2.7 bn.

bn. (2007 Constant)

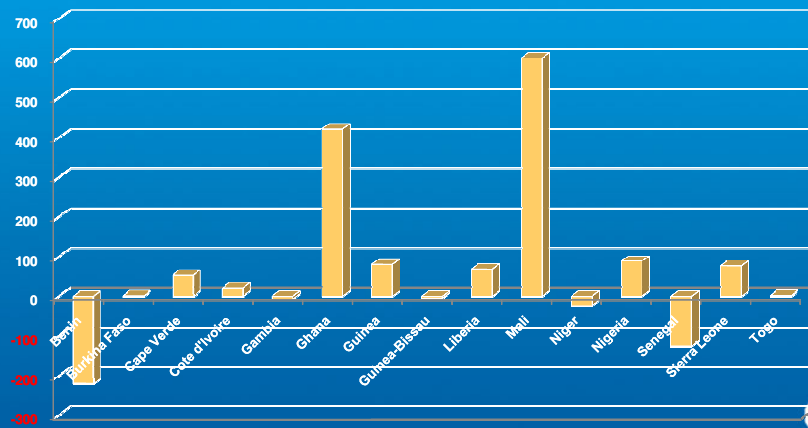


...with an additional \$1 bn. in 2007...



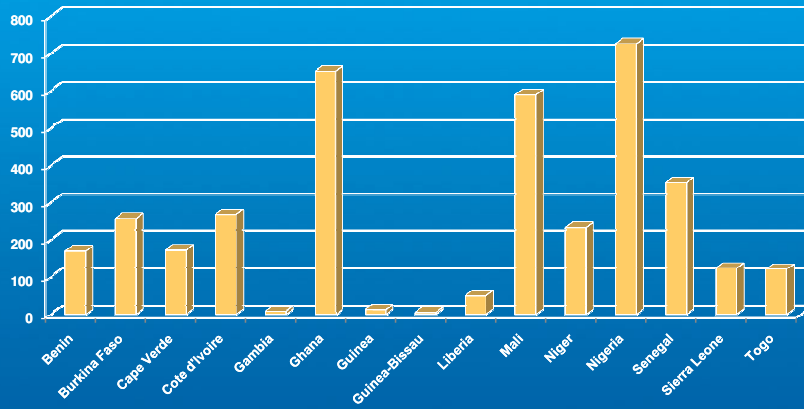
...mostly going to Ghana and Mali...

(US\$ m 2007 constant)



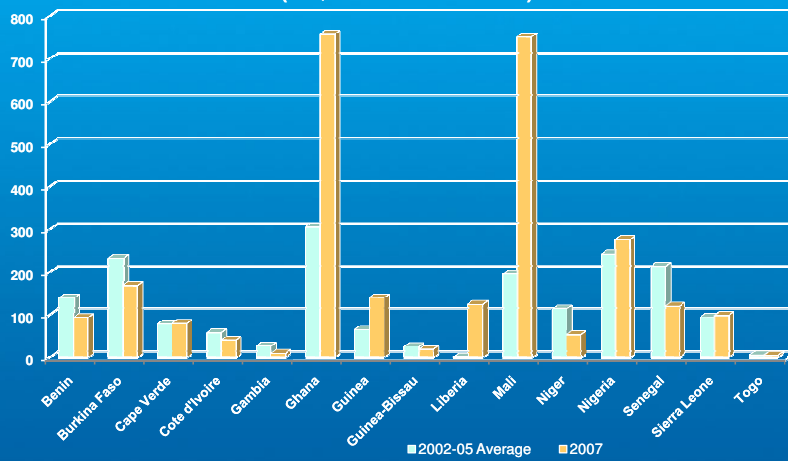
... with further increases in 2008...
